

Walking Guide

Getting to the Theatre



1. Leave Baker Street underground station.

[Go straight ahead from the Bakerloo/Jubilee lines exit or go up the stairs from the Metropolitan, Circle or Hammersmith and City lines.]



2. Outside the station, turn left down Marylebone Road.

[You should see a Sherlock Homes statue on your right.]



3. Ahead, you'll see Madame Tussauds.



4. At the crossing (Allsop Place), carefully cross over and continue straight.



5. Continue past Madame Tussauds.



6. A short distance from Madame Tussauds, turn left onto York Gate.

7. Ahead you'll see some traffic lights and a bridge to Regent's Park.



8. Carefully cross over at the traffic lights.



9. Continue straight over York Bridge.

[You're now in Regent's Park.]



10. Follow the road as it curves slightly to the right.



11. Ahead, you'll see big wrought-iron gates. Continue walking toward them.



12. Carefully cross the road ahead of you toward the gates.

13. Continue through the gates.



14. Take the left turn off of the path ahead of you.



15. You're almost at the theatre. Keep following this path.



16. You'll pass a café on your left.



17. Keep going.

[Don't worry if you don't see the theatre right away - it's well hidden amongst the trees.]



18. When you see the Box Office, you've arrived.

[Staff will be ready to take your tickets and check your bags before your performance.]

19. An 'Important Information' panel is on the left, please read before entering. Information includes the mandatory wearing of face coverings in and around the venue.



20. You will also see a 'Ticket Holders Queue' sign on a tall pole. Please queue here.



21. On arrival, you will have your temperature taken.



22. Tickets will have been emailed to you.

[If you booked more than 28 hours prior to the performance, you would also have received an SMS text on your smart phone with a mobile ticket. Please have either your mobile ticket or printed e-ticket ready for scanning.]



23. There are 'Keep Your Social Distance' signs printed on the floor to help maintain a 2 metre distance whilst queuing. Please stand on the marked signs within your support bubble.



24. As you enter the venue, your bags will be checked.

[Please note: Picnic baskets or other large bags are not permitted.]

25. After entering the theatre, please use the hand sanitiser station in front of you.



26. To the left is a Bike Rack.

[Please note: do not leave your bikes in the Park as gates are locked at dusk.]



27. Follow the signs to the right and into the venue, whilst maintaining a distance from others.



28. Upon arrival, check the Gangway number written on your ticket. To help find your Gangway, signs are located on the trellis above the bar area.



29. If your ticket is for Gangway 5, please wait by the sign and a member of our Visitor Services team will tell you when you may enter. This is to aid social distancing for those sitting in Row J.



30. When you arrive at the bar area, you will see signs for 'Pre-Ordered Drinks Collection'. If you pre-ordered drinks before your visit, please proceed here to collect them, showing your mobile or printed e-voucher.

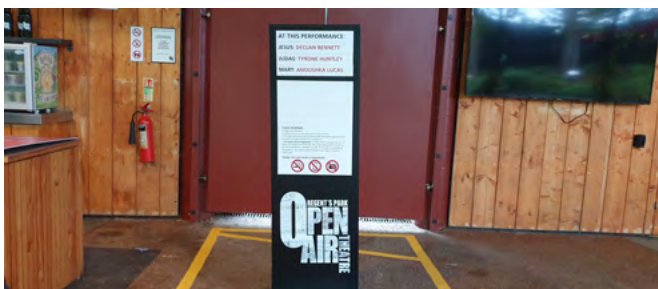

31. If you haven't pre-ordered drinks, proceed to the entrance to the bar. Please follow the one way system: order at the first counter, then proceed to pay at the second counter, and collect at the third.



32. You will see the *Jesus Christ Superstar* cast list on the wall, detailing the cast, creatives and band working on the show. To reduce the amount of hand to hand print, there is no printed programme on sale. More cast and production information can be found at: www.openairtheatre.com/jesus-christ-superstar-the-concert.



33. At each of the Gangway entrances, you will see a sign indicating which cast member will play Jesus, Judas and Mary at that performance.



34. After the bar, you will come to a Merchandise counter. This is where you can purchase blankets, face coverings, water and ice cream.



35. If you wish to visit the toilet, you will see signposts as you head past the bar towards the lawn.



36. Toilets are unisex. Please follow the one-way system in place.

37. In this area, you will find a Water Bottle Refill Station.



38. Entrance to the Accessible Toilets are opposite the lawn.



39. Continuing through the venue, you will see The Grill queue on your left and the lawn screen on your right.

Leaving the Theatre



1. Please maintain social distancing when leaving the auditorium.



2. After exiting via the Gangways, turn right to reach the Theatre Exit Gate.



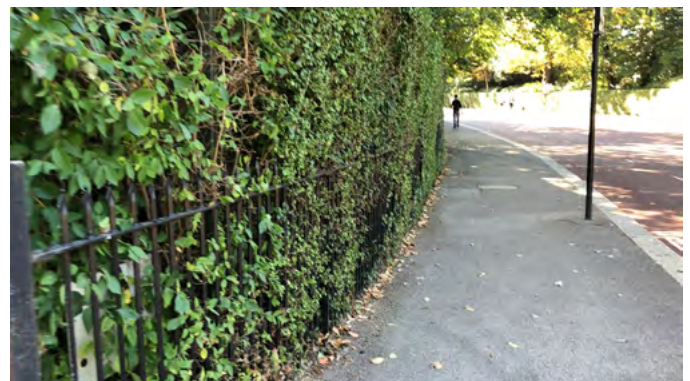
3. Walk away from the bar towards the lawn.



4. Pass the Accessible Toilet entrance on your left and the lawn screen on your right.



5. Keep walking to the Exit Gate.



6. Continue through the gate onto the Inner Circle and turn left to follow the road.

7. You'll pass the café you saw on your way in.



8. Keep walking along the road - it's a little further than you may think - and cross over to the other side.



9. Pass Regent's University on your right.



10. Continue past the university until you reach the corner, then turn right onto York Bridge.



11. You're now going back over York Bridge the way you came. Keep walking straight ahead.



12. At the traffic lights, carefully cross the road.

15. Continue until you reach the busy road ahead - Marylebone Road. Then turn right.



16. Continue along the road towards Madame Tussauds.



17. Continue past Madame Tussauds.



18. Carefully cross the road at Allsop Place.

[You'll need to move across to the right hand side of the divide in the road (as indicated by the arrow above).]



17. Up ahead you'll see Baker Street Underground Station.



18. Turn right into the station.
