We have a reputation for creating first class award-winning theatre specifically for and in our distinctive setting, working both with theatre professionals at the top of their game and nurturing the development of emerging artists.

In the last 10 years, the theatre has won **7 Olivier Awards**, **7 WhatsOnStage Awards**, **4 Evening Standard Awards**, was named **London Theatre of the Year** in 2017 by The Stage, and received the Highly Commended Award for **London Theatre of the Year** in 2021.

Our productions have toured the UK, and have transferred to both the West End and the United States. As a registered charity that receives no public subsidy, the theatre is entirely self-funding, with over 90% of income derived from ticket sales. Nevertheless, we are committed to keeping theatre accessible.

The lowest ticket price of £25 has been maintained for 8 years, and a range of discounts and concessions includes the BREEZE scheme for those aged 18-25, which gives access to tickets to all our productions for just £10. In the past year we have seen an increase of 56% in the number of Members and Patrons, and each year, on average, we subsidise tickets for 6,000 school children to watch a production, with opportunities to continue their learning with our education packs.
