Following current UK Co restrictions requirements for Performing Arts Venues , seating capacity has been dramatically reduced to a maximum of 50 the original capacity of 1,256 seats . 		The entire auditorium is outside; audiences are not sat face-to-face and the use of face coverings is mandatory at all times (other than momentarily to enable eating and drinking when seated). You will not be required to wear a face covering if: you have a physical or mental illness or impairment, or a disability that means you cannot put on, wear or remove a face covering; or putting on, wearing or removing a face covering would cause you severe distress.
